Dear Registered Voter:

With the recent passage of Proposal 3 in the November 2018 General Election, **registered voters can now request an absentee ballot without providing a reason.** Under Michigan election law, you are eligible to be placed on an absent voter Automatic Application List.

Benefits of being on the Automatic Application List:

- You will automatically receive an absent voter ballot application for every election.
- If you choose to return the application, we will send you a ballot as soon as they arrive in our office.
- You will **avoid potentially long lines** at the polls.
- You can take your time studying the ballot and **vote from home** when you are ready.

To be added to the list, please complete the information on the other side of this card and fold it so that your information is on the inside, place a stamp on it, and mail it back to the Clerk's Office. You can also drop it off at City Hall by visiting the Clerk's Counter or using the white drop box marked "Election Materials" found on the circle drive.
