SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Breaking and Entering

On January 30th at approximately 3:00 AM, Farmington Public Safety responded to the Shell gas station located at 37375 Grand River on a report of a breaking and entering. Responding officers arrived to find that the front door was pried open. Investigation revealed that two B/M suspects broke in and stole multiple bottles of alcohol and cash. The case was turned over to the Detective Bureau for further investigation.

Fleeing and Eluding

On February 2nd at approximately 3:00 AM, a Farmington Public Safety officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a white SUV on Grand River near Power for speeding. When the officer activated the patrol vehicle lights and siren the vehicle increased speed and fled from the officer. The case was turned over to the Detective Bureau for further investigation.
