SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Retail Fraud

On March 3rd Farmington Officers were dispatched to a local business for a retail fraud report. The owner of the business reported that a black male subject in his 40s stole a high end bottle of alcohol. Officers reviewed the in store camera system and learned the following. A black male subject in his 40's wearing a black winter hat and coat is observed taking a bottle of alcohol from the shelf and placing it inside his jacket. The male subject then walks to the counter without paying, and eventually leaves the store. The case has been turned over to the Detective Bureau.

Disorderly Conduct

On March 6th at approximately 11:17am Farmington Officers responded to the parking lot of this department for a possible stalking complaint. Officers arrived on scene and found a woman in an irate state. It was later determined that the female was violating a court non contact order with a protected party involved. While officers were investigating the situation the woman became aggressive and refused to follow lawful commands given by officers. The female was eventually taken into custody and issued a citation for disorderly conduct and obstructing police.

UDAA

On March 12th at approximately 04:45am officers responded to Smithfield Street for a resident reporting that their vehicle was stolen. The resident reported that the vehicle's keys were left in the vehicle and was taken between the hours of 9:30pm on 3/11/2023 and 04:45am on 03/12/2023.
