WEEKLY RECAP

December 7 – December 13, 2015

DROVE WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED

On December 7th at approximately 8:07 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Orchard Lake and Shiawassee for disobeying a red light. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended license and a warrant for his arrest. The driver was arrested for driving on the suspended license and housed at the Farmington Jail.

DROVE WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED

On December 8th at approximately 9:36 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Farmington Rd and Eight Mile for having an expired license plate. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended license and warrants for her arrest. The driver was arrested for driving on the suspended license and housed at the Farmington Jail.

WARRANT OTHER POLICE AGENCY

On December 8th at approximately 12:35 PM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Farmington for disobeying a red light. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a warrant for his arrest out of a nearby police agency. The police agency was unable to pick up the driver so he was advised of his warrant and released.

FIRE ALARM

On December 8th at approximately 1:41 PM officers and Engine 3 were dispatched to a business on the 34000 block of Nine Mile Rd for a fire alarm activation. Upon arrival officers learned that the fire alarm was activated because an employee had accidentally burned food on the stove.

IDENTITY THEFT

On December 8th at approximately 7:19 PM a Smithfield resident came into the Public Safety Department to report that he had been the victim of an identity theft. The man reports that an unknown person had opened a Kohl's credit card account in his name and charged approximately \$90 to the account. The victim does not have any suspects and does not know how his information was compromised.

PROBATION VIOLATION

On December 9th at approximately 12:27 AM a Sergeant on patrol observed a subject fall off of his bicycle and into a ditch. The Sergeant checked on the subject and found him to be highly intoxicated. The man is on probation with the 17th District Court for Operating While Intoxicated second offense. The man agreed to take a preliminary breath test with a result of a .19 BAC. The man was driven home and a probation violation report forwarded to the 17th District Court.

FRAUD

On December 9th at approximately 10:48 AM officers were dispatched to a bank on the 23000 block of Farmington Rd for a fraud complaint. Upon arrival officers met with a bank employee and the victim who advised the following: The victim has an apartment that he needed a roommate for. The victim posted an advertisement and a suspect from out of state responded. The suspect agreed to pay a rent of \$500 a month, but had sent a check of over \$6,000 to the victim. The victim called the suspect and was advised by the suspect that the suspect's new employer must have accidentally sent the suspect's moving expenses to the victim. The victim agreed to cash the check, withdraw \$500 for rent, and then send the remainder to the suspect. Several days after sending the remaining money to the suspect, the victim learned that the check was fraudulent. The incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.

LOUD MUSIC

On December 9th at approximately 2:40 PM officers were dispatched to a condo complex on the 31800 block of Grand River Ave for a disturbing the peace complaint. Upon arrival officers spoke with the complainant who was upset that she could hear her neighbor's stereo. Officers spoke with the neighbor who agreed to turn the music down.

RECOVERED CELL PHONE

On December 9th at approximately 4:02 PM a Farmington High School student came into the Farmington Public Safety department to report that she had lost her Iphone at the Livonia Recreation Center while on a school field trip. The student checked her "findmyiphone" app and discovered that her Iphone was at a home on Wakefield St in Farmington Hills. Officers went to the Wakefield residence and retrieved the phone from another Farmington High student who had been on the same field trip. The phone was returned to its owner and the report forwarded to the Farmington High School administration for their investigation.

HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT

On December 10th at approximately 7:47 AM an officer took a report of a hit and run accident in the area of Orchard Lake and Leelane. The investigation revealed that a silver Ford Focus had gone off the road and struck a no parking sign. The Ford then fled the scene heading north on Orchard Lake. The investigation is ongoing.

DISORDERLY PERSON

On December 10th at approximately 1:01 PM officers were dispatched to assist a health care worker in calming down a mentally challenged patient who was causing a scene at the

Farmington Library. Officers helped calm the man down and convince him to go with his care worker.

FIRE ALARM

On December 10th at approximately 4:19 PM officers and Engine 3 were dispatched to a report of a fire alarm at a nursing home on the 34000 block of Grand River Ave. Further investigation revealed that the alarm was false.

WIRES DOWN

On December 11th at approximately 9:47 AM a Farmington High Student came into the Farmington Public Safety department to report that an unknown person had forcefully entered the victim's vehicle while it was parked at the Farmington High School the evening before. Officers noted that it appeared that an unknown suspect had used a "slim jim" tool to gain entry to the vehicle and attempted to remove it's GPS unit. Officers noted that the GPS unit was heavily damaged but was obviously pried at. The victim advised that her cell phone and Ipad mini were stolen from inside the vehicle.
