## **WEEKLY RECAP**

**December 21 – December 27, 2015**

### **LARCENY IN A BUILDING**

On December 21<sup>st</sup> at approximately 11:15 AM an officer was dispatched to an apartment on the 36000 block of Grand River Ave. for a report of a larceny. Upon arrival the victim advised the officer that 12/17/2015 she noticed that her Apple iPad was missing from her apartment. The victim suspects that someone from maintenance must have been inside her apartment and stole the iPad.

### **FAIL TO STOP AND ID AT AN ACCIDENT**

On December 21<sup>st</sup> at approximately 9:16 PM officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle versus pedestrian crash at Grand River and Grove St. Upon arrival officers learned from the two pedestrians that they had been walking across Grove when they were struck by a vehicle that had been turning north onto Grove from Main St. The driver of the vehicle checked on the welfare of the two pedestrians, noticed that they had only suffered minor injuries and then left the scene. The responsible driver was located who advised that she had accidentally struck the two pedestrians but left because she thought they told her it was okay to leave. The report is forwarded to the Oakland County Prosecutor's office seeking charges against the driver.

### **OPERATE WHILE INTOXICATED**

On December 22<sup>nd</sup> at approximately 2:31 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle for a defective equipment violation in the area of Shiawassee and Power. Further investigation revealed that the driver exhibited signs of intoxication. The driver failed several sobriety exams and was subsequently arrested for operating while intoxicated. In addition, a check on the driver's license revealed that her license was suspended. The driver submitted to a Datamaster breath test with a result of a .19 BAC. The driver was housed at the Farmington Jail.

### **DROVE WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED**

On December 22<sup>nd</sup> at approximately 10:09 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Hawthorne for a vision obstruction. Further investigation revealed

that the driver had a suspended license and a warrant for his arrest. The driver was arrested for driving on the suspended license and was housed at the Farmington Jail.

### **DROVE WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED**

On December 22<sup>nd</sup> at approximately 10:36 PM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Drake and Freedom for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended license. The driver was arrested for driving on a suspended license and was housed at the Farmington Jail.

### **LITTERING**

On December 23<sup>rd</sup> at approximately 3:37 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Whitaker for the passenger throwing a take-out container out of the car window (littering). The officer confronted the driver who admitted to throwing out the Styrofoam food container and advised that he didn't know what he was doing as he did it. The passenger was issued a citation for littering.

### **IDENTITY THEFT**

On December 23<sup>rd</sup> a Farmington resident reported at the public safety department that an unknown suspect had taken out a loan in the victim's name to purchase two all-terrain vehicles. The report was forwarded to the detective bureau for further information.

### **NEVER ACQUIRED DRIVER LICENSE**

On December 23<sup>rd</sup> at approximately 8:59 PM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Shiawassee for making an illegal lane change. Further investigation revealed that the driver had never obtained a driver's license. The driver was arrested for never acquiring a license and was processed at the Farmington Jail. The driver was released with a citation.

### **DOG AT LARGE**

On December 24<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:42 AM an officer was dispatched to a residence on the 22800 block of Power Rd for an aggressive dog. Upon arrival the victim advised that she was delivering mail for the post office when a German shepherd left its property and chased the victim down the street. The dog's owner was contacted who advised that the dog must have gotten out of the back yard. The dog's owner was cited for having a dog at large.

### **OPERATE WHILE INTOXICATED**

On December 26<sup>th</sup> at approximately 12:20 AM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Farmington Rd and Manor for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the driver exhibited signs of intoxication and was 19 years old without a license. The driver failed several sobriety exams and was subsequently arrested for operating while intoxicated. The driver submitted to a Datamaster breath test with a result of a .15 BAC. The driver was held at the Farmington Jail.
