WEEKLY RECAP

December 18, 2017 through December 24, 2017

DWLS, Warrant and OWI Arrests

Between December 18 and 24th, FDPS personnel made three (3) misdemeanor driver license related or warrant arrests and four (4) operating while intoxicated arrests as a result of conducting proactive traffic enforcement.

Civil Matter

On December 18, 2017 at approximately 5:44 PM Officers responded to a Farmington Apartment complex for what was reported as a stolen automobile. The Sergeants subsequent investigation revealed that the vehicle was not stolen, but lent out to a friend. The reporting party was advised that the matter was a civil matter.

Larceny from Automobile

On December 19, 2017 at approximately 6:51 AM Officers responded to a residence on Orchard Lake Road for a report of a vehicle that was broken into and moved. The victim stated that they woke to find their 2018 Jeep Compass in the center turn lane of Orchard Lake with a broken driver side rear window. The vehicle was found to be missing the factory stereo, the broken window, damage to the rear lift gate and missing some personal items. The case was turned over to a Detective for further follow up.

Stolen Vehicle

On December 20, 2017 a resident of a Farmington Apartment complex reported that their company vehicle was stolen sometime between December 19th at 2:00 PM and December 20th at 6:30 AM. The Detective in charge of the case was advised that the GPS tracker on the vehicle showed that it was in Detroit. The Detective is working with the Detroit Police Department and the vehicle's owner to locate the stolen vehicle.

Warrant Arrest

On December 22, 2017 at approximately 8:23 AM Officers responded to a Farmington business for a report of a terminated employee that was causing a disturbance and refused to leave. Upon arrival the Officers located a subject matching the description provided by the caller. Officers learned that the subject had a verbal altercation with their employer and was subsequently terminated. A computer check of the subject revealed that the subject was wanted by a number of other agencies. The subject was arrested.

Open Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle

On December 23, 2017 at approximately 6:43 PM Officers responded to the rear of a business in the area of Grand River and Halsted. Upon arrival, Officers noted that the vehicle was stuck in a snow bank, its driver appeared to be highly intoxicated, but vehicle at the time of their arrival was parked. The Officers requested the assistance of CEMS and the subject transported to the Hospital and issued a citation for having open alcohol within the vehicle.
