Description Road surface repairs to Grand River following water main break repairs

Requested Action Move to award Grand River roadway surface repairs to Major Contracting in the amount of \$35,000 and allow City Administrators to execute contract documents.

Background

Last winter, Public Works conducted two (2) emergency water main repairs within the MDOT Right of Way of Grand River. MDOT is requiring the roadway surface to be replaced by a prequalified MDOT Contractor. City Administration and OHM Advisors have requested quotes from contractors; we have open contracts with (ASI, VIL, & Hartwell). Only ASI was able to provide a quote, Hartwell is too busy, and we determined VIL needs to remain focused on the completion of Oakland Street.

MDOT provided contacts of Major Cement Company/Contracting and Great Lakes Contracting Solutions, both are MDOT pre-qualified and experienced with conducting roadway repair within the MDOT Right of Way.

Quotes for were recently received for the necessary patch repairs in Grand River Ave. near Tana Ct. and Lake Way. Three (3) contractors provided quotes to complete this work. Quote results ranged from \$27,472.00 to \$55,300.00 (see enclosed contractor quotes).

We reviewed all three quotes and contractors. The lowest quote was received from Major Cement Co., located at 15347 Dale St., Detroit, MI 48223, in the amount of \$27,472.00.

It is felt that Major Cement Co. is capable of performing the work based on past experiences and information we have been provided with the quote. Based on the submitted information, it is recommended that the Grand River Patchwork job be awarded to Major Cement Co. of Detroit, MI in the amount of \$35,000.00 which includes approximately \$7,500 in contingency.

Dear Michael,

We are pleased to quote the asphalt patches required at the above referenced project. Our bid is in accordance with email provided and includes the following:

Asphalt/Concrete Patches on Grand River Avenue (Approx. 475 SF)

- 1. Traffic control including lane closures and steel road plates;
- 2. Sawcut and remove cold patch asphalt to a depth of existing roadway assume 12.5";
- 3. Install butt joint for smooth transition;
- 4. Furnish and install 9" reinforced concrete per MDOT specifications;
- 5. Provide and install 2" of MDOT #5E3 asphalt material and compact;
- 6. Apply tack coat for adhesion;
- 7. Provide and install 1.5" of MDOT #5E3 asphalt material and compact;
- 8. Layout & install affected centerline striping;
- 9. Clean up and remove all ASI-related debris.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Except as specifically noted above, no allowance has been made for bonds, permits, testing, engineering, layout, inspections, excavation, butt joints, undercutting, traffic control/flagmen, barricades in ROW, striping, signage, irrigation/utility repairs (including private utility lines & street lights) winterization (including blankets/additives to concrete) or landscape restoration.
- 2. If undercutting is required, it will be billed at a unit rate of \$40.00/ton, with an exact quantity to be determined.
- 3. If additional 21AA crushed concrete is required, it will be billed at \$25.00/ton, with the exact quantity to be determined.
- 4. Our bid is based on completing work during the 2021 paving season in one mobilization.
- 5. If additional concrete thickness is required, it will be billed at \$1.50/SF per additional inch.
