

# FARMINGTON DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY MINUTES

#### SPECIAL MEETING – EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Saturday, January 17, 2015 Conference Room A, City Hall

The meeting was called to order at 12:37p.m. by President Andrade.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

### 2015-16 WORK PLANNING

Robert Donohue, Main Street Oakland County, discussed the evolution of the work-planning process and the paradigm shift anticipated at the national level at the Main Street Center. Main Street will not abandon the four-point approach of organization, design, economic restructuring and promotions, but is trending to permit communities to work plan based on projects versus standing committees. Each project would have a champion responsible for assembling a team, creating a project work plan and completing the project, with board approval.

Knowles distributed a copy of the current work plan, with modification to show how it might look converted to a project-based plan with a project champion.

The Executive Committee then prioritized the following projects for presentation to the full board at its February 4, 2015 meeting.

- Infrastructure parking wayfinding, Farmington Road Streetscape Promotion Campaign (if given a green light for 2016), maintenance and public utilities, holiday decorations
- Downtown marketing a comprehensive communications plan which includes an ad series in partnership with the City, web site and social media, directories – print, kiosk or phone app, printed newsletters and press releases; Ladies Night Out, Small Business Saturday, 2017 Art on the Grand, Rhythmz in Riley Park, Harvest Moon Celebration, Volunteer Management and Appreciation

- Business Development business recruitment, business assistance with marketing information or through the Oakland County Business Center for retention, redevelopment projects (as opportunities arise)
- Miscellaneous Block Captains

New projects to be added or proposed include Innovate Farmington, a First Fridays effort, Inside:Out Promotion Campaign, Capital Projects, which may involve a design charette compliments of MSOC, parking advisor to City Committee, Historic District Amendment and Historic Education, which may involve a guided walking tour featuring downtown's historic properties.

Knowles will prepare a draft work plan project listing for the board meeting, when items will be discussed and champions identified. Without a champion, projects are subject to elimination. Champions were identified for several projects, all of which will be noted on the draft that will be prepared for the board.
