### Background:

As you know, the Farmington Public Schools (FPS) is currently marketing the sale of the Flanders School site. In order to get ahead of any possible concerns or misinformation, I am recommending that City staff hold a public meeting with residents in the Farmington Meadows and Farmington Oaks subdivision to discuss the City's vision for redevelopment of this site. I think it is important for them to know:

- 1. The site is master planned for single-family residential;
- It is zoned single-family residential;
- 3. City Administration feels that any residential development that takes place on that site will be similar in character and quality with the existing homes;
- 4. City Administration feels it is important to allocate 1 to 2 acres of the ten acre site for a neighborhood park.

I would like to schedule this in early-mid September and preferably at a nearby location such as St. Gerald's. Furthermore, we would work in conjunction with FPS broker Greater Northern Realty regarding concept plans
