UNFINISHED BUSINESS

CONSIDERATION TO ADOPT ORDINANCE C-724-2007 TO AMEND CITY ZONING MAP, 33350 NINE MILE ROAD FROM INDUSTRIAL TO C-2

Dan Blugerman, rezoning applicant, was present to answer questions. He thanked Council and City Administration for their ongoing cooperation in property development.

<u>09-07-162</u> MOTION by Buck, seconded by Knol, to adopt Ordinance C-724-2007 to amend the City Code, Chapter 35, Zoning Chapter, to amend the Zoning Map and district boundaries established under 35-62 to rezone and reclassify property at 33350 Nine Mile Road from Industrial District (IND) to Community Commercial District (C-2). CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE REVISED HISTORICAL COMMISSION BY-LAWS

Mayor McShane expressed concern regarding the provision in Article Six of the By-laws concerning the need to submit recommendations to Council. City Manager Pastue responded this step would be necessary only under very limited circumstances.

<u>09-07-163</u> MOTION by Wright, seconded by Wiggins, to approve an amendment to the Historical Commission by-laws, adding Article Six, Committees, subject to the review and approval by the City Attorney. [SEE ATTACHED BY-LAWS]. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATE #5 FOR SHIAWASSEE ROAD

Responding to a question from Councilmember Wright, Pastue stated the construction cost thus far is still well under the original estimate.

Councilmember Knol asked about final restoration of the road project as it relates to landscaping. Director Gushman acknowleged minor restoration work items remain, however, the 5% retainage provision in the contract ensures they will be completed.

Mayor McShane noted residents have expressed concern regarding the completion of the final restoration.

Councilmember Wiggins expressed concern regarding the left turn lane at the High School as it relates to parking on Shiawassee, especially during school events. Director Nebus responded a review of traffic control orders on Shiawassee is currently underway.

RESOLUTION 09-07-164 Motion by Knol, seconded by Wiggins, to approve payment of construction estimate #5 to Peter A. Basile Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$717,390.53 for the Shiawassee Road Construction Project.

CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE NINE MILE PUMP STATION SLUICE GATE REPAIRS

City Manager Pastue noted the sluice gate repairs were originally included in the 2006/07 budget at a cost of \$65,000. He stated the Oakland County Drain office re-estimated the repairs at \$50,000.

RESOLUTION 09-07-165 Motion by Wiggins, seconded by Knol, to authorize the Oakland County Drain Commission to proceed with the repair of the sluice gates at the Nine Mile Road Pumping Station and to approve a budget amendment to increase the Pumping Station budget in the Water and Sewer Fund by \$50,000.

RESOLUTION 09-07-166 Motion by Knol, seconded by Wiggins, to approve the purchase of 200 tons of road salt at \$25.90 per ton and 1,100 tons (plus or minus 30%) at \$31.32 per ton from Morton International, Inc., Salt Division, through the State of Michigan Extended Purchasing Program.
