

FARMINGTON MILITARY AND VETERAN BANNER PROGRAM APPLICATION

The City of Farmington is proud to offer the Veteran Banner Program to honor those who have served or are currently serving in the United States Armed Forces. Approved banners will hang on the decorative light poles in downtown Farmington from May through November. Each banner will display a photograph of the service member or veteran, their rank, name, branch of service, dates of service and awards. At the end of the season, banners will be returned to the purchaser. In order to apply for a banner, the service member must be a current member or honorably discharged member of the United States Armed Forces. To apply:

- Complete this form
- Submit a photograph of the service member or veteran in their U.S. Armed Forces uniform
- Submit proof of service (e.g. U.S. Armed Forces ID card, honorable discharge certificate such as their DD214
- Submit a payment of \$225.00 to the City of Farmington, Michigan
 - Submit an optional 500 word or less story about the service member or veteran – the essay will be included on our Military Banners webpage at www.farmgov.com/militarybanners
