Requested Action:

Background:

The Friends of the Governor Warner Mansion, a 501(c)(3) organization, was established in 2011 to focus public attention on the Mansion as a historical asset of the City; to pursue fund raising opportunities; and to develop and support events at the Mansion.

ORDINANCE No. C-719-2006

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDERS

Portfolio

THE CITY OF FARMINGTON ORDAINS:

That the Traffic Control Order issued by the Director of Public Safety of the City Of Farmington, dated February 1972, is hereby amended as follows: as provided for in Section 28-1153 of the Uniform Traffic Code, as adopted in Section 31-51 of the City Code of the City Of Farmington, and Section 31-60 of the City Code of the City Of Farmington.

Chapter 14 – Municipal Parking

AMEND:

Section 14.5 – Municipal Lot, Grove Street from Grand River to Orchard Street (C-719-2006)

(a) Parking shall be limited to a maximum of **three (3) hours** between 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
