SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

FIRE-WIRES DOWN: 09/03/2026

Officers responded to Shell gas station after a primary power line fell onto a parked Audi SQ5. An employee reported hearing a loud boom before discovering the line on the vehicle and calling 911. Officers secured the area with caution tape and observed scorch damage to the hood. No arcing was present, but employees were instructed to avoid the vehicle until DTE could safely address the downed line.

Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol / Liquor OWI 3rd Offense: 09/03/2026

An officer patrolling the area of Orchard Lake and Grand River Ave observed a red G6 vehicle failing to stop or slow down at the intersection. Vehicles had to come to a sudden and abrupt stop to avoid a crash with the red G6. The officer immediately conducted a traffic stop and learned the driver was under the influence of alcohol. The driver had two prior OWI convictions, making this a third OWI violation and a felony.
