VACATING UNIMPROVED THIRD STREET AND CASS STREET WITHIN THE DELOS DAVIS ADDITION SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF FARMINGTON

At a meeting of the City Council of the City of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, held on the 30th day of November, 2015, at the City Hall, 23600 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan 48335.

WHEREAS, the Farmington City Council held a public hearing on April 21, 2014 to consider and hear objections to the proposed the vacation, discontinuance, or abolition of certain public roads within the City of Farmington, within the Delos Davis Addition to the Village of Farmington, Liber 2, Page 36, Oakland County Records, as follows:

- Unimproved Third Street south of Warner Street
- Unimproved Cass Street west of Thomas Street

WHEREAS, the City Council has jurisdiction to vacate the streets in question; and

WHEREAS, the Farmington City Council is satisfied that the described portions of such streets are not and will not be needed as a public way or alley and may be vacated without any adverse effects on the public health, safety, and/or welfare; and

WHEREAS, no portion of Third Street is within 25 meters the general course of a stream; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Cass Street appears to be within 25 meters of the general course of a stream.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Farmington City Council that:

A. Unimproved Third Street south of Warner Street

and

B. Unimproved Cass Street west of Thomas Street

as depicted and shown on Exhibit A shall be and hereby are vacated. An easement for the construction, maintenance, repair, use, and replacement of drainage and utility (including, but

not limited to, sewer and water) improvements, is hereby reserved in, over, upon, and through the entirety of such streets. This action is taken pursuant to Sections 2526 and 2527 of Act 288 of the Public Acts of 1967, as amended, being MCL 560.256 and MCL 560.257.

- 2. Within 30 days after the effective date of City Council's approval of this Resolution, the City Clerk shall submit for recording a certified copy of this Resolution with the Oakland County Register of Deeds, and shall file a copy of this Resolution with the office of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.
- 3. The vacation of Third Street shall be effective on the date this Resolution is recorded with the Oakland County Register of Deeds, and upon the vacation of the portion of such street becoming effective, the portion of such street shall be removed from the street plan map and any other official maps or street plans for the City of Farmington.
- 4. To the extent that the vacation of Cass Street requires by law the filing and resolution of an action in the Oakland County Circuit Court, such vacation shall be effective on the date judgment is entered granting such vacation and filed or recorded as required by law, and upon the vacation of the portion of such street becoming effective, the portion of such street shall be removed from the street plan map and any other official maps or street plans for the City of Farmington.
