A RESOLUTION OF THE FARMINGTON CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE

Motion by Councilmember McShane, seconded by Councilmember Wright, to adopt the following resolution:

- WHEREAS, the Farmington City Council discussed forming a Beautification Committee at its December 7th meeting; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember JoAnne McShane provided a history of the previous Beautification and its successor the Commission on the Environment; and
- WHEREAS, it was discussed that it would be desirable to create a new Beautification Committee with a limited scope and responsibility but with the possibility of expanding if it is deemed necessary.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Farmington City Council hereby establishes a Beautification Committee with the following purpose and committee structure.

1. Purpose

- a. Consider and propose programs which would improve the physical appearance of the community and implement them as approved by the City Council;
- b. Organize and execute an annual effort to encourage citizen participation in activities designed to beautify the city;
- c. Continue with the Beautification Awards Program; and
- d. Assist where needed with the Community Garden Program; and
- e. Other possible projects and agreed upon by the Committee and City Council.

2. Committee Structure and Composition

- There shall be seven members selected by the City Council serving staggered three-year terms;
- b. The Committee members shall select amongst themselves a chairperson, vice chairperson, and secretary.
- c. The Committee can form sub-committees from their members, and outside, to for specific projects and programs;

Proposed Motion:

None. Discussion of the purchase of 7 bleachers for Shiawassee and Drake Park

Background:

The City has wood bleachers at the baseball/softball fields at Shiawassee and Drake Park. There are currently 5 bleachers at Shiawassee and 6 bleachers at Drake. The wood bleachers are difficult to maintain, requiring frequent painting and board replacement. Additionally, the bleachers lack railings and boards crack throughout the season, creating hazards for spectators. See attached picture of one of the bleachers at Drake Park earlier this summer.

Administration would like to replace the bleachers at both parks with an aluminum style bleacher. This type of bleacher would more durable and require less maintenance. Quotes were solicited from 8 vendors. See attached. If approved, one bleacher would be purchased at each field, for a total of 7. This purchase is not currently budgeted. Funds would be taken from the Capital Improvement Millage Fund, Fund Balance.
